



ATTENTION CITIZENS OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKESHORE

In response to the various announcements regarding cancellations and suspensions across Canada due to the outbreak of the Corona Virus (COVID-19), the Rural Municipality of Lakeshore administration has been requested to ensure that Emergency Management Plans are in place to address the developing situations with the ongoing spread of the Corona Virus (COVID-19).

Council and administration have discussed various scenarios on what to do regarding the possible virus outbreak which may affect our organization, and how it could affect the functions of the Municipality. It has been determined that services should be prioritized as follows:

1. Water and Sewer Services – **Must Operate**
2. Fire Service – **Must Operate**
3. Public Works – **Must Operate (Possible Modifications)**
4. Council and Management Staff - **Must Operate (Possible Modifications)**
5. Office Staff – **Operate (Possible Modifications)**
6. Recreation Facilities – **Closed Until Further Notice**
(Community Centers, Resource Center, Library, etc.)

Water and Sewer Services and Fire Protection Services are priority for the operation of our Municipality. Therefore, these resources will operate for continued service.

Services not related to water, sewer, or fire, may be limited at times, or temporarily suspended according to the required response.

Council and Staff for the Rural Municipality of Lakeshore appreciate your co-operation and understanding as the situation develops, which may, or may not have an effect on our ability to provide full operational services. Essential Services will not be interrupted unnecessarily. We are depending on the expertise of Provincial Public Health to provide guidance on the matter to respond and maintain safety in our communities.
